- Work as part of a team, supporting colleagues in the day to day running of the nursery.
- Adhere to the nurseries policies and procedures
- Responsible for a key group of children, building relationships with parents and maintaining Parent partnership.
- Responsible for the care routines of the children, changing nappies, feeding etc
- Responsible for safeguarding the children.
