Dust ledges. Spot clean walls. TASKS TO BE CARRIED OUT: Furniture and fittings, toilets, sinks, windows, doors, floors, cookers, pianos, radiators, kitchen units, cupboards, skirting boards, fire extinguishers and walls up to 3m high. PPE will be provided, and you are expected to always comply with COSHH and H&S practices. HOURS OF WORK: Flexibility is expected with regard to overtime if required in an emergency. Holidays must be taken during school holidays.
